



ITINERARY FOR OVER THE HORIZON SAFARI

Number of Days: 11 Days

Operating in 4 x4 vehicle on shared basis

Safari Departure and Arrival timings:

Safari Briefing: Day 02 at 0700hrs approx.

Departs on Day 02: 0730hrs approx.

Returns on Day 07: 1330hrs approx. (flights to be booked 1600hrs onwards)

Pick up point Day 02: Four Points Sheraton Hotel

Drop off point: City Hotel or JKI Airport

Over the Horizons is a popular safari in Kenya, where lodges are stylish, guides are knowledgeable and scenery extraordinary. From Gerenuk browsing vertically in the Samburu, to the resident hippos of the Mara River, this is an exhilarating safari.

Day 1 Nairobi

Upon arrival into Nairobi, clients will be met and transferred to the Eka hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

Overnight at **Four Points Sheraton Hotel** in a Standard room on a bed and breakfast basis.

Suggested Optional Nairobi Excursions for Early morning arrivals: Daphne Sheldricks Excursion Or Out of Africa Excursion.

Day 2 Nairobi - Samburu Game Reserve

Leave Nairobi after an early breakfast for Samburu, heading north, you pass near Thika and continue north through some breathtaking scenery dotted with rushing mountain streams and fields of tea and coffee. After Nanyuki town, continue north, eventually reaching a dusty outpost known as Isiolo, the last major stop on the journey into the remote northern frontier district. From here it's a fairly short hop to Samburu. Arrival at the camp in time for lunch and then depart for an afternoon game drive returning to the camp as the sun sets.

Overnight at **Samburu Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 3 Samburu Game Reserve

Early morning game drive is followed by breakfast, and time to relax by the camp pool or the terrace overlooking the river. After lunch there will be another game drive returning to the camp as the sun sets.

Overnight at **Samburu Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 4 Samburu Game Reserve – Aberdares - Nakuru

Leaving Samburu behind after breakfast, clients will travel South through Isiolo, crossing the foothills of Mount Kenya. On the other side of the mountain is Nanyuki, where you turn south, passing through Naro Moru, where you reach Nyeri, one of Kenya's major towns and provincial headquarters and then on to the Aberdare Country Club. Enjoy a bounteous buffet lunch amidst the beautiful gardens before you continue with your onward journey. You head north-west, heading towards Nyahururu, followed by travel in a southerly direction to your next destination, arriving in the late afternoon. You will proceed on a game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park, returning to your lodge as the sun sets. The national park, known for its birdlife, offers a possibility to view flamingoes. It is also home to Black and White rhinos as well as the endangered Rothschild Giraffe.

Overnight at **Sarova Lion Hill Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 5 Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara Game Reserve

After an early morning game drive and breakfast, drive to Narok town via Mai-Mahiu with a brief rest stop and proceed on to Mara arriving in time for lunch at the camp. After lunch, depart for an afternoon game drive returning back to the camp as the sun sets.

Overnight at **Mara Leisure Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 6 Masai Mara Game Reserve

Early morning and afternoon game drives. (It is possible to pre-book an optional early morning Balloon Safari)

Overnight at **Mara Leisure Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 7 Masai Mara Game Reserve – Nairobi - Amboseli

After breakfast depart the Masai Mara and head across acres of rolling wheat and barley farms to Narok, the district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. From here cross the vast plains on the floor of the Rift Valley whilst keeping an eye out for herds of giraffe and gazelle before heading up the rift escarpment. Arrive into Kenya's bustling capital in the early afternoon. After picking up your picnic lunches in the city, you will proceed on to Amboseli where you arrive in the late afternoon.

Overnight at **Oltukai Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 8 Amboseli National Park

Morning and afternoon game drives in Amboseli, returning to the lodge as the sun sets.

Overnight at **Oltukai Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 9 Amboseli – Nairobi

Following a morning game drive the rest of the morning is at leisure followed by lunch at the lodge. Following Lunch, depart to Tsavo West. The journey takes you east, across the spectacular Shetani lava flow, a reminder of the molten outpouring that spilled down the scenic slopes of the nearby Chyulu Hills over the last three centuries. A zig-zagging road through scrub thorn and acacia leads you into Tsavo National Park, which together (East and West) form the largest of Kenya's parks. On arrival, enjoy game-viewing en route to your lodge arrive at your lodge as the sun sets.

Overnight at **Kilaguni Serena Safari Lodge** on a full board basis.

Day 10

This morning enjoy a game drive in the park, including a visit to Mzima Springs with its underwater viewing holes. Following lunch at the lodge, continue to Taita Hills Game Sanctuary for rest of the afternoon at leisure, viewing game from lodge's underground hide or from the lodge balconies.

Overnight at **Sarova Saltlick Game Lodge** on full board basis

Day 11

Following breakfast, you will be transferred to the Standard Gauge Railway for your train back to Nairobi. In Nairobi, you will be met and transferred to a city hotel or the airport for your onward flight arrangements.

End of Services.

Child and Third Adult Policy

- One child aged 6-11 sharing with 2 adults pays 55% of safari cost
- Children aged 6-11 in own room pay 75% of safari cost
- Third Adult sharing pays full per person sharing rate
- Children under 12 pay 50% of festive supplements
- Transfer Supplements – children under 12 travelling with 2 Adults pay 50%

Children younger than six are discouraged from joining seat-in-vehicle safaris however, we would be pleased to provide a private safari for families with young children.

Cost Includes

- Meet and greet services
- All transport and game drives on safari sector will be in a Mini Bus vehicle with pop-up roof (maximum 7 passengers) with a Bi-lingual English-speaking driver-guide on shared basis
- Guaranteed window seat
- Meals and accommodation as specified
- All park fees and government taxes
- ½ litre bottle mineral water per person per day on game drives

Cost Excludes

- Visas and international flights
- Airport taxes (clients pay direct)
- Driver-guide gratuities
- Drinks, dining rooms tips, portorage
- Personal travel, baggage and medical insurance
- Telephone bill, laundry and any items of a personal nature
- Balloon Safari
